

## THE RASPBERRY

Raspberry cultivation dates back to the Middle Ages.

It is a slightly thorny bush with a small size (it rises from 0.80 to 2 m in height) and superficial roots.

The leaves are dentate, frequently covered with a white duvet on the underside.
